AWSCPA EDUCATOR OF THE YEAR AWARD ANNOUNCED

Taylor Morris received this recognition from Amy Knowles-Jones, AWSCPA President, to recognize excellence in teaching and inspiration in the accounting field by a faculty member of a two- or four-year college.

Dr. Taylor Morris is an accounting faculty member at Sam Houston State University, earning her PhD from the University of San Diego and MBA and BS in Accounting degrees from the University of Houston-Clear Lake (UHCL). Her primary teaching areas are auditing and financial accounting and her research interests are in auditing, accounting ethics, and leadership, and was also named the 'Outstanding Accounting Educator Award' winner from the Texas Society of CPAs.
