EDUCATOR OF THE YEAR ANNOUNCED

DAYTON, OHIO -- The American Woman's Society of Certified Public Accountants (AWSCPA) has announced that its Educator of the Year award was recently presented to Dr. Teresa Danile, CPA, CMA, at the 2014 Women's Accounting and Leadership Conference in Morristown, N.J. It is given by AWSCPA to an individual for outstanding contributions to accounting education.

Teresa Danile received her undergraduate degree and Master's of Business Administration degree in Accounting from Pace University in New York City in 1976. She went to work as an auditor for Hurdman and Cranstoun and later Price Waterhouse Coopers. In 1979 she began her teaching career as an adjunct lecturer at The College of Staten Island. The following year she joined St. John's University as an Assistant Professor. In 1980 she began an Accounting and tax Practice as part of her tenure requirement, and still maintains that growing practice today, serving business and individual clients.

Her dedication to service is evidenced by the many committees on which she has served at St. John's as well as in her community. Teresa also served as Assistant Chair and Chairwoman of the Department of Accounting and Taxation in the Peter J. Tobin College of Business. She is the faculty advisor to the Eta Mu Chapter of Beta Alpha Psi on the Staten Island campus and serves as a mentor for the KPMG Diversity Leaders Program on both the Queens and Staten Island campuses.

Teresa is a Certified Public Accountant and a Certified Management Accountant and is a member of the American Institute of CPA's and Institute of Management Accountants, where she served on various committees. She is also Past President of the New York and New Jersey Chapters of the ASWA.
