PRESIDENT'S AWARD ANNOUNCED

DAYTON, OHIO -- The American Woman's Society of Certified Public Accountants (AWSCPA) has announced that its President's Award was recently presented to Yasmine El-Ramly, CPA/CITP CPA by 2013-2014 National President Kelly Welter, CPA at the 2014 Women's Accounting and Leadership Conference in Morristown N.J. It is given by AWSCPA for significant, long-term contributions to the profession and the Society, at the recommendation of the entire AWSCPA Board of Directors.

Yasmine El-Ramly is a Senior Technical Manager of Firm Services & Global Alliances. She oversees women's initiatives programs, human capital and international projects. Her responsibilities include the enhancement of the PCPS Human Capital Center and the International resource center along with the oversight of the AICPA firm strategy initiative and the firm intelligence gathering process. Yasmine also manages the PCPS relationship with HR professionals and the external relationship with the World Bank, IFAC, GAA and international firm associations. Finally, Yasmine serves as staff liaison for the AICPA Women's Initiatives Executive Committee, which is the AICPA's driving force for women's progress in the profession. She has been instrumental in working with the volunteers of this committee, and it has grown to 13 members and includes men and women.

Prior to joining the AICPA, Yasmine worked for CPA firms of various sizes: a big four, a national firm and a local firm. Yasmine also worked in France for a start-up company before relocating to the United States to pursue a graduate degree and her CPA license. Yasmine has authored many published articles in recent years so such as *Women in Accounting- Removing the barriers to success.*
